- 7) Further detail on Port Macquarie for next year:
  - a) There will be a 5pm meeting / happy hour on the first night to discuss the final arrangements, which will be dependent on weather and tides. This will be followed by two full days in the field. People will return home on the fourth day.
  - b) Port Macquarie Excursion: "When the Ocean Floor Came Ashore!", 18th to 22nd June 2018. Suggest staying at Flynns Beach Caravan Park (02)6583 5764 which has cabins and caravan sites and well off Main Street. There may be a limit of 20 people due to the difficulty of access to one area in particular (Rocky Beach).
  - c) There will be a 5pm meeting / happy hour on the first night to discuss the final arrangements, which will be dependent on weather and tides. This will be followed by two full days in the field. People will return home on the fourth day.
  - d) The tour will begin with the Geotrail walk along the top of the cliff line. This will be followed by detailed exploration of some of the more interesting areas at Tacking Point, Lighthouse Beach, Shelley Beach, Flynns Beach, and the section between town and Flynns Beach. The latter will require much scrambling over steep vegetated ground and participants on this the most interesting part will need to be reasonably fit. We will see the exceptionally rare blueschist rocks formed at extreme pressure and low temperature, interesting melanges and rich deposits of manganese, cobalt, nickel, scandium and cerium. We will learn how a big iron ore mine in the centre of town was an important producer over 60 years ago, but no trace remains!
  - e) There will be plenty of time to relax over coffee at numerous excellent cafes and some free time will be available to explore non-geology attractions
